

Jugendstiftung Baden-Württemberg (The Youth Foundation of Baden-Württemberg)



The Youth Foundation of Baden-Württemberg supports exemplary and innovative youth projects in Baden-Württemberg such as music and theatre projects, media work, intercultural or cross-generational exchanges and environmental projects. The task of the Foundation is to reveal pioneering paths in the field of youth education and to test them locally as well as to accompany and support ideas and undertakings of young people.

Besides the funding of projects, the youth foundation also develops concepts and projects either alone or together with partners. The [Qualipass](#) (“certificate of qualification”), the educational-campaign [“Mitmachen Ehrensache”](#) (Participation a Matter of Honour) or the platform [“Menschenrechte – deine Rechte”](#) (Human Rights - Your Rights) in the youth network are only some of many examples.

Who can apply for support at the Youth Foundation Baden-Württemberg?

The Youth Foundation supports non-profit organisations involved in youth education in Baden-Wuerttemberg. In exceptional cases initiative-groups and individuals such as students and pupils are also supported, provided that they are not subject to taxation.

May schools and other public institutions submit a project application?

No, however collaborative projects with private non-profit organisations which are involved in youth education are possible. In such cases, the private organisation must make the application.

Which application deadlines do I have to consider?

Decisions on who to support are made by the board of trustees of the foundation twice a year during meetings which are usually held in April/May and in October. Project applications must reach the foundation’s office about 6 weeks before these meetings. See [Latest News](#) for the latest information regarding the meeting and application dates.

Which documents must I submit with a project application?

The required documents are the project application form and the financing plan, which can be found under [Form-Downloads](#), as well as a copy of your current organisational constitution and a valid certificate of non-profit status.

Are certain costs excluded from support by the Youth Foundation?

Yes, construction costs and personnel costs are excluded from any support by the Youth Foundation.

What is Baden-Württemberg’s definition of the term ‘project’?

A project has a clearly defined project period with a beginning and an end. The project period may not exceed three years. The project-goals must be formulated in a

verifiable manner. Each project involves tangible work and, thus, differs from a mere financing of equipment. A project is a one-time undertaking and not a recurring activity/event and, therefore, differs significantly from your regular business operation.

Are there further financing options?
